- 2. All signatories (including witnesses) must sign the document with hand-drawn signature (either physically or on a tablet / mobile phone using their finger / electronic pencil) before uploading the document on NotarEase.
- 3. The document will then be electronically signed and notarised on NotarEase as per the normal process that can be found on <u>https://notarease.com/resources</u>.
